AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERLIN, COUNTY OF SOMERSET, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING EXTERNAL FUEL BURNING APPLIANCES.

BE IT, AND THE SAME IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED as follows:

SECTION 1. Definition. An External Fuel Burning Appliance for purposes of this Ordinance shall be any appliance or device constructed, designed and/or used to burn oil, wood, coal, charcoal, peat, or any other fuel, which has been manufactured for placement outdoors, but intended and/or used for providing heat to any structure.

SECTION 2. Prohibition. All External Fuel Burning Appliances are hereby prohibited in the Borough of Berlin.


SECTION 3. Penalties. Any person, firm or corporation who shall construct, reconstruct, install, use and/or maintain any External Fuel Burning Appliance in the Borough of Berlin shall be guilty of a summary offense, and shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars, and in default of payment of such fine, shall be sentenced to a term of imprisonment not to exceed Ninety (90) Days. Every day that a violation of this Ordinance continues shall constitute a separate offense.


SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.


